FROM THE DIRECTOR

There were a few days, and even weeks, that didn't seem to end. At times it felt like things just kept coming up. But the result? What you are about to see? It is so, so, so worth it. Believe me when I say that every person listed in your programs has put literal blood, sweat, and tears into this production. It is because of the combined effort of every individual involved in this that we can present our production of Joseph to you today.

My hope is this: When you see this show. When you see this amazing, technicolor miracle we've managed to create. I hope you enjoy it. I hope you have fun. I hope you are transported away from whatever worries you have. But above all that? I hope you are inspired by these individuals. I hope that, through them, you are reminded about all that can happen when you just keep going.
